1. The risk of injury to my child from the activities involved in these programs is significant including the potential of permanent disability and death. While particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist; and
2. FOR MYSELF, SPOUSE, AND CHILD, I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown. EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASES or others, I assume full responsibility for my child's participation.
3. I willingly agree to comply with the program's stated and customary terms and conditions for participation AND NOTE THAT THE RULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE IN THE EVENT OF BAD WEATHER AND/OR OTHER THINGS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF CFPAL. If I observe any unusual significant concern in my child's readiness for participation and/or in the program itself. I will remove my child from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official [or adult supervisor in the case of non-sports related events] immediately.
4. I myself, my spouse, my child, and on behalf of my/our heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, HEREBY RELEASE THE other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("Release"), WITH RESPECT TO ANY AND ALL INJURY, DISABILITY, DEATH, or loss or danger to person or property incident to my child's involvement or participation in these programs. WHETHER ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASES OR OTHERWISE; to the fullest extent permitted by law.
5. I myself, my spouse, my child, and on behalf of my/our heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin HEREBY INDEMNITY AND HOLD HARMLESS all the above releases from any and all liabilities incident to my involvement or participation in these programs, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THEIR NEGLIGENCE, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
6. This agreement shall be governed by the law of the State of Florida and any legal action related to or arising out of this agreement shall be commenced exclusively in the circuit court of the fourth judicial circuit and for Orange County, Florida (or if such circuit court shall not have jurisdiction). I certify I am 18 years of age or older and that I am entering into this agreement as the parent or guardian for a minor under 18 years of age.

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT. FULLY UNDERSTANDING ITS TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT, AND SIGN IT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT.

CODE OF CONDUCT

PAL is a partnership between youth, law enforcement and community volunteers building positive relationships through recreational, athletic and educational programs. Providing youth with positive role models is a vital factor in the success of PAL's programs and, more importantly, in decreasing the chance that youth will become involved in negative behaviors. Therefore, it is extremely important that all staff, coaches, parents and volunteers involved with PAL activities conduct themselves in a manner that is consistent with PAL's mission and policies. **Noncompliance to the Code of Conduct will forfeit participation of any activities/programs.**

- No PAL representative shall consume any alcoholic beverages, ingest or smoke any illegal/nonprescription drugs, or smoke or chew tobacco while conducting any program work or program activities related to PAL.
- No PAL representative or participant will conduct any program work or program activities related to PAL while under the influence of alcohol or illegal/nonprescription drugs.
- No PAL representative or participant shall practice in discrimination based on race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, or any other characteristic or belief that is not regulated and/or prohibited by law.
- No PAL representative will engage in one-on-one contact or activity with PAL youth or their siblings nor will they solicit or allow any social/outside relationships with these youth.
- No PAL representative will transport any PAL youth in their own personal vehicle at any time.
- PAL representatives will operate PAL vehicles only with prior authorization of designated PAL staff. Youth may only be transported in these vehicles with prior authorization as well.
- No PAL representative or participant shall use profanity while conducting PAL-related work.
- No PAL representative or participant shall knowingly violate any City, County, State or Federal laws.
- All PAL representatives and participants must dress appropriately for PAL activities and in a manner consistent with PAL's philosophies (ie. no clothing promoting alcohol, tobacco or controlled substances, no gang attire, no clothing with sexually explicit or discriminatory artwork or slogans).
- All PAL representatives and participants will conduct themselves to the best of their ability in a way that will uphold and promote the mission and standards of PAL.- No individual shall act as a representative or agent of PAL without prior authorization and consent of designated PAL staff, Executive Director or Board members.

YOUTH CODE OF CONDUCT

Trustworthiness, All youth shall;

Be honest, and never deceive, cheat or steal; Have the courage to do the right thing; Work to build a good reputation;

Respect, All youth shall;

Treat others with respect, and be considerate of the feelings of others; Demonstrate a tolerance toward differences; Use good manners, and avoid offensive language and taunting; Never slander, degrade, threaten, hurt or hit anyone; and Deal peacefully with anger, insults and disagreements.

Responsibility, All youth shall;

Use self-control and self-discipline; Be accountable for all choices and actions; Demonstrate reliability; and Exhibit supportive behavior and a positive attitude.

Fairness, All youth shall;

Adhere to all laws, rules, policies, and guidelines; Be open-minded and demonstrate the ability to listen to others;

Caring, All youth shall;

Demonstrate compassion, kindness, and forgiveness; and Provide assistance to others in need when appropriate.

Citizenship, All youth shall;

Respect authority and demonstrate cooperation; and Properly care for all equipment, uniforms, facilities, and playing fields.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS CODE OF CONDUCT

All parents and legal guardians shall pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for their child participating in the activities of Central Florida Police Athletic League, Inc by following this Code of Conduct.

Specific Principles. All parents and legal guardians shall therefore resolve to conduct themselves with dignity as a citizen of the community, recognizing and accepting that they shall:

- (a) Encourage respect and good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other youth activities;
- (b) Place the emotional and physical well-being of their child and the other Athletes ahead of a personal desire to win;
- (c) Support efforts to create and maintain a safe and healthy environment;
- (d) Support coaches and officials working with their child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all;
- (e) Demand a lifestyle that is free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol, and refrains from their use at all Central FL PAL events;
- (f) Do their very best to make youth activities fun;
- (g) Encourage their child to treat everyone with respect regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability;

COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

The primary function of a coach is to facilitate the youth sports environment, and educate Athletes through participation and competition. Each Athlete shall be treated as though he or she is the coaches' own child, and his or her welfare shall be considered uppermost at all times. All coaches shall be aware that they have a tremendous influence on the well being of the Athletes, and thus, shall never place the value of winning above the value of instilling the highest ideals of character.

Specific Principles. All Coaches shall therefore resolve to conduct themselves with dignity as a citizen of the community, recognizing and accepting that they shall:

- (a) Uphold the honor and dignity of the profession;
- (b) Set an example of the highest ethical and moral conduct in all personal contact with athletes, sports officials, parents/guardians, spectators, and the public;
- (c) Take an active role in the prevention of drug, alcohol and tobacco abuse;
- (d) Avoid the use of alcohol and tobacco products when in contact with Athletes;
- (e) Master the contest rules and teach them to his or her team members;
- (f) Respect the rules of all sports, staff of Central FL PAL and the organizations direction
